To manage the databases for a hosting account:

1. Select “Web Hosting & Databases” from the “Hosting & Email” dropdown menu or select “Database List” from the “Hosting & Email” list on the Welcome page.
2. On the Manage Hosting Accounts page, click the Databases link next to the hosting account for which you want to manage the databases.
3. You may modify an existing database or create a new database.

* Clicking the "Enable Access Database Support" link above will create a "private" directory in your hosting directory called "access_db." This directory will already have the appropriate database permissions set. Once created, you should upload your Access database file to the "access_db" directory.

Please note that a File DSN is not required for the Access database to work. The File DSN feature is provided as a convenience. By using a File DSN you can have your database connection information centrally stored for easier code maintenance.

You do not need to run this setup process if you are planning on using Access databases through FrontPage. Instead, FrontPage will handle all Access functionality.
