To set up a hosting account:

1. Click "Setup Account" for the account you want to setup or modify.
2. Enter a Username and password for your hosting account.
3. Select a domain name from the list of domain names in your customer account, or enter a domain name that you may have registered through another account or registrar.
4. Indicate if you would like to include FrontPage Extensions.
5. Click the Save Settings button.

To edit a hosting account:

1. Click Settings next to the account you would like to update.
2. You may make the following updates:
  - change the hosting login password
  - install/uninstall FrontPage extensions
  - manage MX records, sub-domains, total DNS Control, aliased domain names
  - buy additional bandwidth
  - add password protection to your Web statistics
  - add or manage SSL support pack
  - apply or cancel Traffic Facts
  - select a 404 Error Page
